



Hendersonville Regional Walking Guide

Walk # 3 of 4: West Hendersonville

Distance: 1.92 miles

Difficulty: The walking route follows paved sidewalks with minimal slopes.

Highlights: See the corresponding numbers on the map:

- Historic Henderson Co. Courthouse: Golddomed courthouse was built in 1905.
- Henderson County Travel & Tourism: Need more recreation ideas? Stop by Travel & Tourism for free maps and brochures.
- **3.** *Tom's Park*: Relax by the banks of Wash Creek as it lazily flows through the City.
- 4. Sammy Williams Center for Active Living: Offers a variety of programs that encourage older adults to lead healthy, active lives.
- **5.** West Side Historic District: Featuring buildings from the early 1900's, the West Side Historic District contains some of the City's finest residential homes.
- Columbus Mills Pace House: This Victorian house was built pre-Civil War around 1860.
- 7. Henderson County Public Library: Cool down with a good book!
