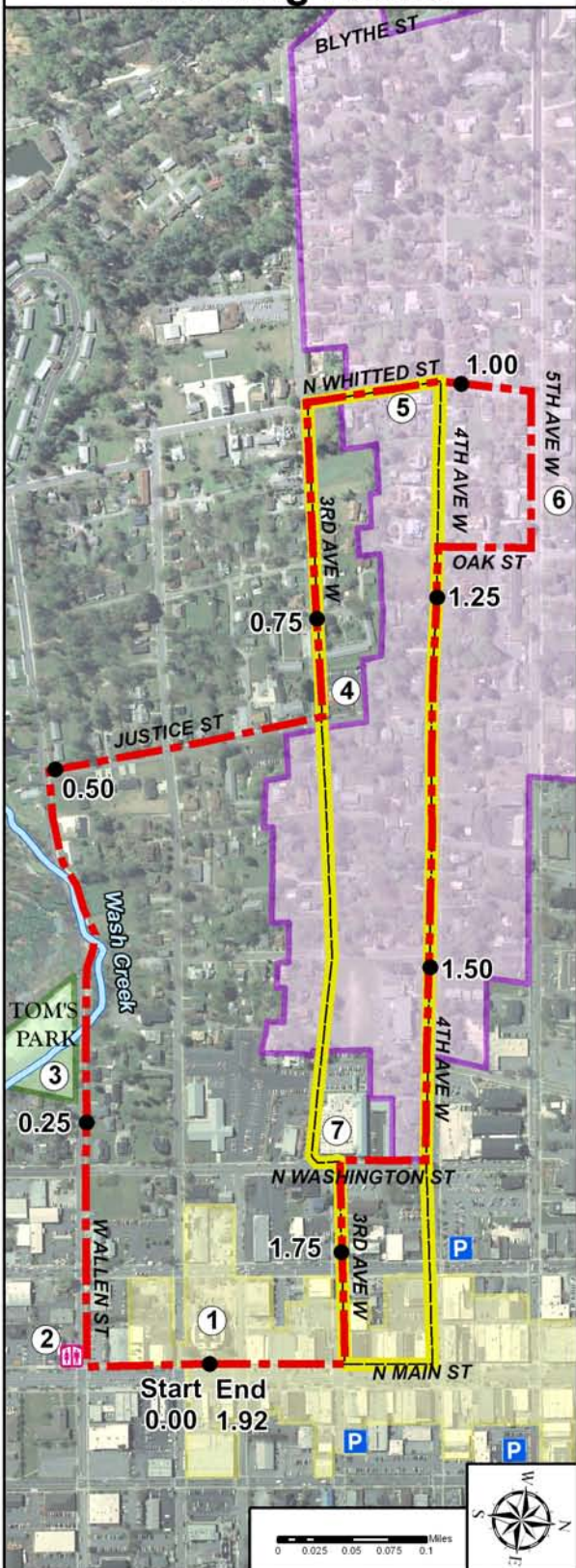
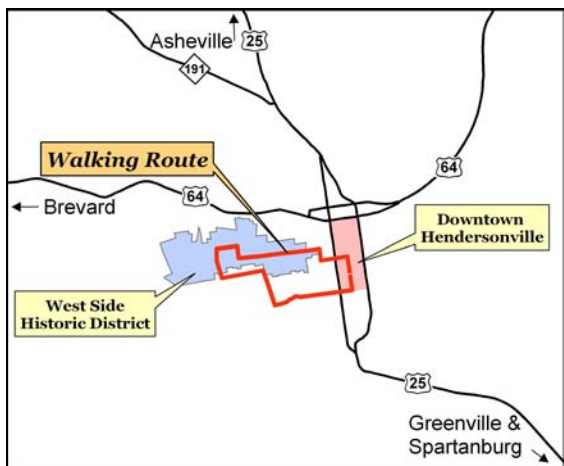


West Hendersonville Walking Route

Hendersonville Regional Walking Guide

Walk # 3 of 4: West Hendersonville

Distance: 1.92 miles

Difficulty: The walking route follows paved sidewalks with minimal slopes.

Highlights: See the corresponding numbers on the map:

1. *Historic Henderson Co. Courthouse:* Gold-domed courthouse was built in 1905.
2. *Henderson County Travel & Tourism:* Need more recreation ideas? Stop by Travel & Tourism for free maps and brochures.
3. *Tom's Park:* Relax by the banks of Wash Creek as it lazily flows through the City.
4. *Sammy Williams Center for Active Living:* Offers a variety of programs that encourage older adults to lead healthy, active lives.
5. *West Side Historic District:* Featuring buildings from the early 1900's, the West Side Historic District contains some of the City's finest residential homes.
6. *Columbus Mills Pace House:* This Victorian house was built pre-Civil War around 1860.
7. *Henderson County Public Library:* Cool down with a good book!
